Guidance on Japan's Border Control Measures Related to COVID-19 (as of Jan. 4)

The Government of Japan has implemented multilayer border control measures in order to mitigate the spread of COVID-19. Foreign nationals arriving from the US or other designated nations/regions will be denied entry into Japan unless there are "Exceptional Circumstances." Effective Dec. 30, 2021, <u>all cross-border travelers</u> from the State of California into Japan are requested to stay for 6 days and the State of Arizona for 3 days at specific facilities designated by the chief of the <u>quarantine station</u>. Those who obtain a negative result of COVID-19 test conducted on the third day and sixth day from the entry into Japan, may leave the facility and are still required to stay for the remaining period of 14 days after the entry of Japan at places such as their own residence.

In Japan, over 201 million doses of COVID-19 vaccines have been administered to date to the general public as of Jan. 4, 2022 with 78.74% of the population now fully vaccinated. As of Jan. 4, the total number of COVID-19 cases stood at 1,733,901 in Japan, and 56,189,547 in the United States, according to the Coronavirus Resource Center, Johns Hopkins University & Medicine.
