Seeking Centenarians for Fall Honors 2021

On behalf of the Government of Japan, the Consulate General of Japan in Los Angeles is currently seeking centenarians **with Japanese citizenship or Japanese ancestry** to be honored in the fall of this year.

Qualified individuals should be **born between April 1, 1921 and March 31, 1922.**

Individuals with **Japanese citizenship** will receive a proclamation from the Prime Minister of Japan and a ceremonial silver cup (*ginpai*).

Individuals with **Japanese ancestry** (but no Japanese citizenship) will receive a certificate from the Consul General.

All interested parties should send the following information to the Consulate General by **May 13, 2020.**
