

# **ONLINE VISA Application for visiting Japan**

Foreign nationals who meet ALL of the criteria below are eligible to use the online application.

- The applicant must be a **U.S. citizen who resides in the U.S.** (\*Green card holders are NOT considered to be U.S. citizens)
- Short-term stay (less than 90 days) for Single-Entry only
- Eligible purposes for applying are A) Business/Conference/Study, B) Visiting Relatives, or C) Tourism (only through package tours, not individual travel).
  \*Applicants visiting acquaintance in Japan are not eligible to apply online

\*Applicants with a criminal record are not eligible to apply online

#### **Required Documents;**

#### **Business/Conference/Study & Tourism**

- A) Copy of passport
- B) Digital photo (facial image)
- C) "Certificate for Completion of Registration issued by the ERFS"

#### **Visiting Relatives**

- A) Copy of passport
- B) Digital photo (facial image)
- C) Invitation Letter
- D) Documents to prove kinship (Birth certificate, Marriage certificate, copy of the family register, etc.)

\*For former Japanese, please submit the Joseki Tohon that reflects you have submitted the Denaturalization Registration (Kokuseki Soshitsu Todoke *国籍喪失届*)

## [Important Notice]

- To obtain an eVISA, it takes 5 business days after you receive the email: [Notice of completion of reception].
- If the documents submitted are not sufficient, we will notify you via email and you will need to withdraw your application and re-apply.

- Please upload a clear, identifiable, forward facing, no-background (either white or blue) passport-type photo.
- Please make sure your ERFS contains your name exactly as shown in your passport (if you have a middle name, it must be reflected)
- Applicant are required to **log onto the JAPAN eVISA Website and display "Visa issuance notice"** at the airport. <u>PDF data or screenshot of the page will not be accepted</u>. <u>How to</u> <u>display</u>.
