

Seeking Centenarians and individuals over 100 years old

On behalf of the Government of Japan, the Consulate General of Japan in Los Angeles is currently seeking centenarians and individuals over 100 years old (Individuals born before March 31,1927).

Among those, individuals turning 100 years old this fiscal year will be honored in the fall this year (Individuals born between April 1, 1926 through March 31, 1927) and also those who have not been honored in the past.

Individuals with Japanese citizenship will receive a proclamation from the Prime Minister of Japan and a ceremonial silver cup (*ginpai*) to congratulate and appreciate their contribution to our society.

Individuals with Japanese ancestry (non-Japanese citizenship) will receive a certificate from the Consul General.
