Enthronement of His Majesty the Emperor

Prime Minister Shinzo Abe visited the U.S. and Belgium on Sept. 23-28. The prime minister attended the 74th Session of the United Nations General Assembly in New York,

Japan-U.S. Trade Pact

On October 7th, 2019, Japan and the United States signed a Trade Agreement on agricultural and industrial goods, as well as on digital trade.

Tariffs on products such as beef, pork, wine and other agricultural goods, exported from

the U.S. to Japan, will be reduced or eliminated. Likewise, tariffs on Japanese agricultural products exported from Japan to the U.S., such as soy sauce and certain fruits and vegetables, will be reduced or eliminated; further, quotas for low-tariff imports of Japanese beef into the U.S. will be expanded.

Tariffs on certain industrial goods from Japan such as machine tools, steam turbines, bicycles and musical instruments will be reduced or eliminated. Substantial elimination of barriers and tariffs on digital products trade, such as videos, music, e-books, software, and games, between Japan and the U.S.
