affirmed their full support to Ukraine. Reach the G7 Statement HERE.




Japan Stands with Ukraine

Consul General Sone Visits Arizona

On Oct. 17th and 18th, the Consulate General of Japan in Los Angeles joined the Japanese semiconductor delegation in Arizona, coordinated by JETRO Los Angeles. As Arizona has been a major home ground to a well-established semiconductor ecosystem, JETRO Los Angeles invited Japanese companies that are keen to study possibilities of business expansion or investment in Arizona to participate in this event. Twenty-seven Japanese companies (Thirty-seven delegates total) joined the mission to better understand the investment, business and living environment in the Greater Phoenix area. Consul General Sone, visiting Arizona for the first time since his assignment to Los Angeles, also joined the mission and highlighted in his remarks that this delegation is expected to be one of the pivotal events of future Japanese investment and further business partnership in Arizona. In addition to separate meetings with Arizona

government and business representatives, <u>Consul General Sone visited the Japanese</u>

<u>Friendship Garden</u>, with plans to return for their upcoming 20th Anniversary celebration.

Guidance on Japan's Border Control Measures

<u>Visit Japan Web -- a service for international travelers and Japanese citizens -- can be</u>
<u>used for Quarantine, Immigration, and Customs declaration procedures.</u> The "Fast Track"
service for quarantine procedures has been available in Visit Japan Web from Nov. 1,
2022.

From midnight Oct. 11, 2022 (Japan Standard Time), all cross-border travelers from the US who fall under <u>visa exemption measures</u> for short-term stay no longer require visa applications. Please click <u>HERE</u> to learn more. In addition, travelers from the U.S. with <u>a valid vaccination certificate of COVID-19</u> are <u>not required to submit the certificate of negative test result of pre-departure COVID-19 test</u> within 72 hours prior to departure from the original country/region.
