On the sidelines of ASEAN-related summit meetings in Cambodia, Prime Minister Kishida met with US President Joseph R. Biden, Jr. for a Japan-US Summit Meeting on Nov. 13. The two leaders shared the recognition that the strong Japan-U.S.

relationship has a significant role to play in regional peace and stability and beyond, and concurred to work together to ensure peace and prosperity in the region and the international community, by further strengthening the deterrence and response capabilities of the Japan-U.S. Alliance and promoting efforts to realize a "Free and Open Indo-Pacific."
