

#### Prime Minister Kishida's US Visit

On Jan. 13, Prime Minister Fumio Kishida visited Washington, D.C. for a summit with U.S. President Joseph R. Biden. The two leaders reconfirmed unprecedented Japan-U.S. cooperation, rooted in the shared vision of a free and open Indo-Pacific and a

peaceful and prosperous world, and guided by the shared values, including the rule of law. Read the <u>Joint Statement of the United States and Japan</u>.



#### Japan-U.S. Foreign Ministers' Meeting

On Jan. 11, Japanese Foreign Minister Yoshimasa Hayashi met with his US counterpart Antony Blinken on the sidelines of the Japan-U.S. Security Consultative Committee held in Washington, D.C.

They reaffirmed that Japan and the U.S. would further strengthen the deterrence and response capabilities of the Japan-U.S. Alliance as a whole including the reinforcement of Japan's defense capabilities to make the capabilities of the U.S. more effective.



#### Japan's Earthquake Disaster Relief, Aid to Turkey

In a statement, Foreign Minister Hayashi offered <u>the</u> <u>Government of Japan's heartfelt condolences and</u>

sympathy to the people of Turkey and neighboring countries such as Syria following the massive earthquake that occured on Feb. 6. In response to a request from the Turkish government, Japan is providing emergency relief goods through the Japan International Cooperation Agency and has dispatched members of the Japan Disaster Relief Expert and Medical Team to the region. Japanese Self-Defense Forces aircraft has also transported equipment and other assets.


