Japan, U.S. Leaders, Foreign Ministers Hold Talks

On Oct. 2, the leaders of Japan and the US held a phone summit, during which <u>Prime Minister ISHIBA Shigeru told his counterpart</u>

<u>President Joe Biden, Jr.</u> that strengthening the Japan-US Alliance is a top priority. <u>Japan's Minister for Foreign Affairs IWAYA Takeshi and US Secretary of State Antony Blinken</u> also spoke on the same day, and concurred to work closely together in preservation and enhancement of the rules-based economic order in the Indo-Pacific region.
