On March 30, Prime Minister ISHIBA Shigeru received a courtesy call from U.S. Secretary of Defense Pete Hegseth. The prime minister stated that Japan would like to work together with the U.S. to realize a "Free and Open Indo-Pacific" amid an increasingly severe security environment. They also exchanged views on Japan-U.S. security and defense cooperation for strengthening the deterrence and response capabilities of the Japan-U.S. Alliance.
